The registration deadline for the conference will be **September 3rd, 2018**, with a registration fee of \$200; registration after that date will be \$230. We will inform the selected contributed speakers as soon as possible. We especially encourage graduate students, early-career faculty, and traditionally underrepresented groups to contribute abstracts.

Just after IWOGL, the 60th Midwest Graph Theory Conference (MIGHTY LX) will take place at Purdue University Fort Wayne, in Fort Wayne, Indiana, on **September 28-29, 2018**. We expect that many researchers may be interested in both conferences and we are making plans to provide travel from Muncie to Fort Wayne for some participants on September 28.
