

A Survey of Digraph Labelings

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In 1985, Bloom and Hsu defined graceful labelings for directed graphs. In the 33 years since, various other types of labelings of directed graphs have been defined and explored including magic and antimagic type labelings. This talk will look at the types of labelings that have been defined on digraphs, the classes of digraphs that have been studied in each case, and some possible directions for future research.
